Dear Shareholder.

The Surfside Colony Main Entry Gate remodel has finally started.

We have been working very hard to make this project a reality and have finally received the building permits and have signed an agreement with Haskett Construction.

The project will entail construction of a new security guard shack and an addition of a residence only entrance lane. It will also include drainage for the main entry gate area ultimately to be connected to the Colony drainage system.

The project will begin this week and will take approximately three months to complete. During construction the front gate exit lane will be closed and everyone will have to exit the Colony at Anderson Street. The entrance lane will be left open as long as possible during construction but will be closed for a short time, we will let you know when as we get further along.

It's anticipated that several parking spaces will be used for construction staging and it would benefit everyone in the Colony if residents could park their cars in their garages or in front of their homes.

We will keep you informed as the project develops via email. If the office does not have your email address, please contact the office with that information.
