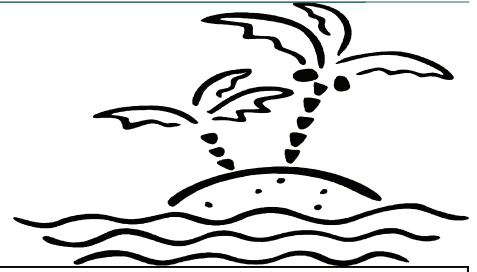

NOVEMBER ELECTIONS	4TH OF JULY CELEBRATION!	SUMMER IS HERE!
There will be an election in November and there is an opportunity for Surfside Residents to serve on the local Tax Districts Boards. The Surfside Colony Community Services District has four 4 Director Offices, and the Surfside Colony Storm Water Protection District has 5 Director Offices, for which an election will be held on November 2, 2010. California Government Code requires Directors to (1) establish policies for the operation of the District through independent judgment on behalf of the interests of the District, and (2) to act in a trustee capacity subject to the prudent investor standard when making investment decisions. Interested parties must be registered voters in the Districts and must file in person with the County of Orange Registrar of Voters between July 12, 2010 and August 6, 2010.
